PROPER USE OF SPACE HEATERS

*There is a potential hazard of fire from improper use or use of unapproved types of space heaters

GENERAL GUIDELINES FOR USE OF SPACE HEATERS

Know how your heater works

- Space heaters must be electrically powered
- Space heaters must be listed by a qualified laboratory. Such as UL/ETL or certification from CSA international
- To prevent loss of power through circuit breaker tripping, no more than one (1) space heater should be plugged into any electrical circuit
- Always plug heaters directly into a wall outlet/receptacle DO NOT USE EXTENSION CORDS OR POWER BARS
- Space heaters must have a thermostat that shuts off the unit when specified temperature is reached

Provide space & stability for the heater

- Space heaters must have a tip-over shutdown feature
- If a space heater is knocked over, the unit must automatically shut off
- Space heaters must be kept at least 3 feet away from combustible material (such as rugs, curtains, clothing and furniture)
- Power cord must not be frayed or damaged
- Power cords must not run under carpets or rugs
- Power cords must not extend through areas of travel

Always Supervise your Space heater

- Space heaters must be located in plain sight and clearly visible
- Use space heaters only on the floor (flat, solid ground)
- Do not use space heaters in wet or moist places such as bathrooms.
- Space heaters should be used as a temporary measure during a loss of heat condition.
- Space heaters must always be turned off and unplugged when area being heated is not occupied. DO NOT LEAVE HEATER ON UNATTENDED or while you sleep
